Dosage:

Admix 7 may be dosed at 2 ounces to 12 ounces per 100/weight of total cementitious material. Typical applications range from 5 ounces to 10 ounces per 100/weight

Mixing:

Admix 7 may be added at any time during the process of creating concrete. Best practice is to add desired amount of Admix 7 after all dry materials, but before final balance of mix design allowable water is added to mix.

Standard dispensing equipment for water-based admixtures may be used.
